I often may ask you to show or send me your notes or work for lessons or problems.

- Check the daily agenda on Google Classroom to see what you missed
- Click on any links/files assigned for that day to complete the missed work
- Talk to a classmate if you are confused or need any help

- Make sure you turn in the Assignment for the day

Grading:

You will be graded daily on a variety of different items including: daily participation/problem completion, homework, quick checks, projects, quizzes, and tests.

Points will be assigned in the following way:

- Quick Checks: 10-15 points
- Quizzes: 25 points
- Tests: 50 points
